



Summer Staff Job Description

NATURE OF THE POSITION:

AS A SUMMER STAFF MEMBER, YOU WILL GET TO WORK AS PART OF A VARIETY OF DIFFERENT AREAS THAT ARE A PART OF THE MINISTRY OF CAMP THAT INCLUDE THE CAMP STORE, RECREATION, THE KITCHEN, CLEANING, AND MAINTENANCE.

EACH POSITION WILL ALSO ASSIST WITH CAMP CLEAN-UP, TURN-AROUND AT THE END OF EACH CAMP SESSION, AND HAVE OTHER DAILY SERVICE RESPONSIBILITIES.

AREAS OF WORK:

Store/Recreation:

Store/Rec Staff are responsible for working as Lifeguards (if certified), Go-Cart and Waterslide Operators, camp store staff, and vending machine stockers.

Lifeguards:

We utilize a team of Lifeguards to maintain safety at our pool and lake front .Lifeguard specific responsibilities include maintaining clean and safe environments, as well as overseeing and assisting with all water activities and cleaning the pool. Lifeguards will need to obtain certification prior to the summer.

Kitchen Staff:

Kitchen staff members will work in the kitchen, preparing and serving meals. They are responsible for serving each of our guests and offering exceptional customer service.

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AREAS OF WORK (continued):

Weekend Host:

Weekend Hosts assist guest groups by providing excellent customer service and hospitality. You must be hard-working, trustworthy, responsible, flexible, and have the ability to problem solve. This position requires you to live on-site at camp during your scheduled time (typically Friday afternoon - Sunday afternoon).

Cleaning:

Cleaning Staff will be assigned daily cleaning duties and will assist with camp turn around after the departure of a group/camp session.

QUALIFICATIONS:

What we are looking for:

Hard-working High School (must be at least 16 years old) and College-age individuals who are passionate about serving others and deepening their relationship with Christ through discipleship and community.

Position details and requirements:

- Submit an online application, complete a background check (if 18+), & be interviewed either in person or via Zoom/telephone
- Required to live on-site at Camp Dixie
- Be willing to get Lifeguard Certified
- Attend mandatory staff training
- Serve campers, guests, and other staff with a Christ-like attitude
- Will be paid by salary weekly
- Will have 2 scheduled days off within each 2-week period (additional time off for family & school events may be requested)
- Be plugged into a small group for discipleship, mentorship, community, and accountability
- Have specific duties but also be expected to willingly serve camp as a whole
- Be expected to seek the Lord daily, fully relying on His strength and doing everything for His glory

APPLICATIONS ARE DUE BY MARCH 1ST, 2024

ALL APPLICANTS MUST COMPLETE:

- **ONLINE SUMMER STAFF APPLICATION.** Go to campdixie.com and click on the "Get Involved" tab.
- **SPIRITUAL REFERENCE** completed by your current pastor, youth pastor, campus minister, or spiritual mentor is required for each applicant. These will be submitted via an online survey.
- **BACKGROUND CHECK** (if 18+) - Upon submission of your application, you will receive an email with further instructions on completing the form online.

ONCE THE APPLICATION IS COMPLETED:

- You will receive a confirmation email from us letting you know we have received your application. The confirmation email will contain a link to our background check form that you will need to fill out. You will be contacted as needed to schedule an interview.
- Our aim is to complete the hiring process in the first half of March. Once hired, you will receive a Ministry Agreement outlining sessions and rate of pay.
