## LODGING

Jordan, Galilee, Mt. Hermon, \& Mt. Carmel Each dorm sleeps 36 (18 bunk-beds) and is divided into 6 rooms. There are 2 bathrooms per dorm for a total of 4 showers and 4 toilet stalls.
Nile Dorms 7-12
Each dorm sleeps 26 ( 7 bunk-beds in front, 6 bunks in back). There are 2 bathrooms in each dorm for a total of 3 showers and 3 toilet stalls.
Cypress Inn (Private) Units 1-6
Available at an additional charge of $\$ 25.00$ per unit, per night (in addition to the per person charges). These units sleep 4 ( 2 double beds) and have a private sitting area, bathroom, and small kitchenette.

MEETING AREAS
Mt. Zion
Offers a meeting/dining area which accommodates approximately 75 people, a private kitchen, and two private restrooms (each with 1 shower).

Main Building
The main kitchen, dining facility, camp store, vending machines, office for guest use, restrooms, and chapel are all located in this building. The chapel, located on the upper level, accommodates approximately 300 people.
Education Building
Our Education Building features 5 rooms, 3 of which can be opened into 1 large meeting room capable of seating approximately 200 people.

South of Saint Pauls: Take I-95 North to Exit 31, (Hwy. 20.) Turn Right, continue 7 miles through and out of the town of St. Pauls. Turn Left onto Pages Lake Road at Faith Tabernacle Christian Center. Camp Dixie will be 3 miles down on the Right.

North of Fayetteville: Take I-95 South to Exit 46 South, (Hwy. 87 South.) Continue towards Elizabethtown, approximately 13 miles. Pass Dupont \& cross over the railroad tracks, then 2 miles down, there will be a "Camp Dixie next right" billboard. Turn Right onto Bladen Union Church Road, Camp Dixie will be located on the Left less than $1 / 2$ mile from Hwy. 87.

East of Tar Heel: Take Hwy. 87 North to and through Tar Heel. Approximately 8 miles past Tar Heel, turn Left onto Bladen Union Church Road opposite the William O. Huske Locke and Dam. Camp Dixie will be located on the Left less than $1 / 2$ mile from Hwy. 87.
